

ORGANIZATION

The Sweetwater Ladies Golf Association (SLGA) was established to encourage women to actively participate in playing golf and to take part in tournaments under the United States Golf Association (USGA) rules and regulations.

The SLGA promotes two groups at Sweetwater Country Club, the 18-Hole group and the 9-Hole group. An established handicap of 36 or less is required for membership in the 18-Hole group. The 9-Hole group is open to all skill levels, with some experience recommended.

The annual dues for 18-Hole membership are \$75. Dues for 9-Hole membership are \$60. These dues cover prizes for tournaments, year-end awards and other costs incurred by the association. The Pro Shop charges an additional fee of \$40 annually for handicap maintenance in the GHIN system.

The association holds weekly playdays, hosts several tournaments each year, and participates in Interclub competitions with other private clubs in the area.

The Executive Board of the association meets periodically to plan and direct the activities of the membership. A meeting of the general membership is held before play on the first Thursday of the month as directed by the Executive Board.

All members are encouraged to attend.

18-HOLE YEARLY ACTIVITIES

Weekly Playdays

Regular play is held each Thursday at 9:00 a.m. Please note start times may vary during the summer, on meeting days, and for special events. Sign-ups are done via email or by phoning the Tournament Chair (see contact information on back). Members are asked to sign up by the preceding Tuesday to be included in that week's game.

18-Hole Major Tournaments

There are several major tournaments throughout the year: the Handicap, Member-Member, President's Cup, Turkey Tournament, and the Club Championship. Additional events include the Beauty and the Beast Tournament, a friendly competition held annually with our Senior Men's Golf Association, and Sugar Bowl, a head-to-head competition with neighboring Sugar Creek Country Club. Details for all SLGA events are forwarded via email.

18-Hole Interclub Tournaments

The SLGA currently participates in Southwest Interclub. This organization offers monthly opportunities to play competitive golf with other private clubs in the area. There is an entry fee, and each tournament concludes with an awards luncheon. Interclub information and sign-ups are forwarded via email.

9-HOLE YEARLY ACTIVITIES

For those ladies with limited time, just returning to the game, or just getting started, the 9-Hole group offers weekly playdays and various themed tournaments throughout the year. Participation in Interclub competitions with other private clubs in the area is also offered for a small entry fee.
